

## Faculty Position in Earth Sciences at National Taiwan Normal University

The Department of Earth Sciences at National Taiwan Normal University invites applications for **one** faculty position in **Geophysics**. This position will start either in the February or August of 2018, depending on the hiring procedure. The position is expected to be at the Assistant Professor level, but a higher level appointment may be considered for exceptionally qualified candidates.

Candidates specializing in survey/observational/theoretical/statistical geophysics are welcomed. The preference will be given to individuals who can offer innovative interdisciplinary proposals (no more than 2 pages) and to work with other groups in this department (astronomy, oceanography, atmospheric science, and geology). Candidates who have experience on big data analysis, Earth system science, interaction of Earth's spheres, and risk analysis of multiple natural hazards are strongly encouraged.

The appointees should have a demonstrated record in research and a commitment to excellence in undergraduate and graduate teaching and provide his/her teaching plan. It is expected that the candidate will have a Ph.D. in Geophysics at the time of the appointment with preference given to those with post-doctoral experience and whose interests, abilities, and experience benefit our existing programs.

Applicants should submit a cover letter, a current CV, a publication list, a description of how your future research and teaching will contribute to the overall goals of the department, a (photo) copy of doctorate diploma, and arrange three letters of reference directly sent to:
